Recently, the Learning Partnership\* in Budapest 'E-MAP' was launched. Seven partners from seven different European countries participate in this Grundtvig Lifelong Learning Programme\*\*. For two years these European colleagues will research how to implement self-evaluation and monitoring in order to achieve quality management for small organizations operating in the field of adult education. They focus on sharing and learning. They are convinced that a shared understanding of quality in adult education will lead to changes in personal competencies as well as in organizations.

\* The Grundtvig programme focuses on the teaching and study requirements of people involved in adult education or in alternative education streams, as well as in institutions and organizations offering these services. Support of lifelong learning and mobility is also a way of addressing the problem of Europe's ageing population.

\*\* The Lifelong Learning Programme (LLP) provides opportunities for individuals and organizations across Europe that are involved in education and training of adults to learn to co-operate in order to broaden their experience of other cultures. LLP's main priority is to promote lifelong learning in communities by inspiring active citizenship in order to improve social cohesion and thereby reducing inequality among people with different cultural backgrounds.
